

### Alcohol Rules & Regulations Norway

The rules and regulations around the purchasing, serving and importing alcohol are stricter in Norway as opposed to other European countries.

Alcohol is heavily restricted, taxed and monitored as part of the countries strategy to curb alcoholism. This can make it very expensive and heavily taxed. We understand that the serving of alcohol is important to our exhibitors and plays a key part in the networking of the event.

#### Purchasing Stand Catering

We have worked with the venue to negotiate the best prices available for our exhibitors. These will be available to order through an online shop when the manual is live. You can find details on the following page of what is available. All orders **must** go through the venue for alcohol. If the product you are looking for is **not** listed, then please contact the below to see if they can source it for you.

#### Importing Alcohol

In Norway you **must** use an approved importer/distributor and all deliveries **must** be made to the venue official caterers (De Bergenske). Due to licensing restrictions they have to make the delivery to the stand. There is a surcharge applied for this service.

#### Serving Alcohol

Any alcohol **upto 22%** can be served without a bartender before 13:00.

Any alcohol **over 22%** can only be served after 13:00 and must have a venue bartender on the stand. They can only be hired for a minimum of 3 hours at a cost of NOK 365,- ex vat per hour.
